A more direct path to a job

SFP is an education for teachers in the county of Stockholm and situated in central Södermalm. You will study in groups, and other students will have a similar background and education to yours. Together you establish contact networks in and outside of school.

With us you will get:

- intensive education for teachers with a foreign background
- Swedish with a professional focus
- to accompany a teacher for a period of time
- a good foundation to continue studying for Swedish teaching certification
- an education in cooperation with Stockholm University to be validated on an individual basis.

Requirements for applying:

- You need a teaching certificate, or to have worked for a few years as a teacher and have a degree in a subject that is included in a teaching certificate.
- You must have been in Sweden less than three years.
- You must know English at level English 4.

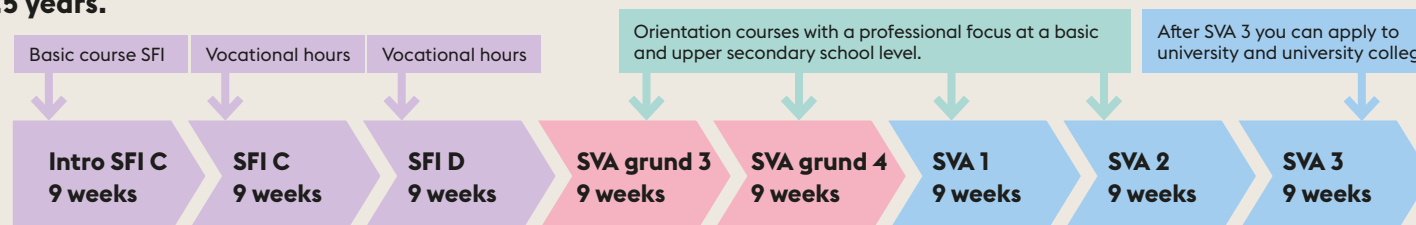


This is how you apply:

- Admissions take place at Vuxenutbildningscentrum in Stockholm, Rosenlundsgatan 52.
- Send your foreign education certificates from university or university college to Universitets- och högskolerådet (UHR).
- Contact Universitets- och högskolerådet to have your degree and certificates evaluated.
- You can begin your application to SIFA while awaiting an answer from Universitets- och högskolerådet.

The education is at most 1.5 years.

Without prior knowledge of Swedish, your education as a beginner starts at level C. If you already know some Swedish, you start at the level that is right for you. You will study in cohesive groups. After you have completed a course you will directly start at the next level.



Having graduated from SIFA, you meet entry requirements for Continuing Professional Development for Foreign Teachers (Utländska Lärares Vidareutbildning, ULV) at Stockholm University.
